Different ways to present your GLO

Create a 'short cut' for a packaged GLO on the desktop

Go to the folder where the GLO file was saved, double click to go inside this folder. Inside the folder will be a file called 'Glo_Player.html'.

Right click on this file, from the options that appear, choose 'Create a shortcut'. This will produce a 'Shortcut to Glo_Player.html' icon which you can drag to your desktop.



Using a VLE

You can add your GLO to the learning materials provided for your course within a VLE. All files included in the packaged version of the GLO must be uploaded to the VLE environment, but just link to the '**GLO_Player.html**' file to run the GLO. The following example uses London Metropolitan's WebLearn facility (which is provided by Blackboard).
